<b>WHY?</b>	WHAT DOES DES MOINES METRO CREDIT UNION (DMMCU) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
<b>WHAT?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
<b>HOW?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Social Security Number</li><li>• Loss History</li><li>• Payment History</li><li>• Credit History</li><li>• Transaction History</li><li>• Overdraft History</li></ul>

For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

<b>Who is providing this notice?</b>	Des Moines Metro Credit Union	
<b>WHAT WE DO</b>		
<b>How does DMMCU protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
<b>How does DMMCU collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal information when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open an account</li><li>• Apply for a loan</li><li>• Give us your contact information</li><li>• Provide account information</li><li>• Make a wire transfer</li></ul>	
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li><li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li><li>• Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li><li>• State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</li></ul>	
<b>DEFINITIONS</b>		
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>Des Moines Metro Credit Union has no affiliates.</i>	
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>Des Moines Metro Credit Union has no nonaffiliates.</i>	
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• CUNA Mutual Group</li><li>• Affinion</li></ul>
